<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 2 two-inch black binders</li> <li>2. 4 reams of copy/printer paper</li> <li>3. 1 package Washable Crayola brand markers (no pastels or bold)</li> <li>4. 2 packages of baby wipes</li> <li>5. 2 packages of handwriting paper</li> <li>6. 2 packages of dry erase markers</li> <li>7. 2 packages of Clorox disinfecting wipes (any brand)</li> <li>8. 4 Glue sticks</li> <li>9. 4 boxes Crayola brand crayons (16 or 24 count)</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 1 three-inch black binder</li> <li>2. 2 boxes of storage bags with zipper (quart or sandwich size)</li> <li>3. 4 120 count Spiral Wide-Ruled Notebooks</li> <li>4. 4 plastic pocket folders with pockets and brads (red, green, yellow, and blue)</li> <li>5. 1 pair blunt point scissors (<i>No pointed scissors</i>)</li> <li>6. 1 package of large or small paper plates</li> <li>7. 2 containers of hand sanitizer</li> <li>8. 1 plastic pencil box</li> <li>9. 24 #2 plain yellow pencils</li> <li>10. 2 large boxes of facial tissues</li> </ol>

**Notes on Backpacks:** Scholars are required to use a backpack that is large enough to hold pocket folders. It must have two straps and be a typical backpack (no purses, messenger bags, rolling bags, etc. are allowed).
