

2024-2025 Homework Expectations

Laureate believes that homework can support scholar learning beyond the classroom. Homework should be meaningful and aligned to grade-level standards. It may not be 100% aligned to the lesson for the day, but should be aligned to something that has already been taught to the scholar.

Families are expected to provide a focused space for scholars to complete their homework. We highly recommend removing all electronic devices during homework time and using physical books vs. ebooks.

Below is an outline of what to expect from nightly homework.
